Rotary sponsors Interact Clubs at Sierra Ridge and Camino Schools. These clubs offer an opportunity for students ages 12-18 to provide service to their schools and communities with Rotary guidance and assistance.

A Monthly Community Breakfast is held the second Saturday of each month from January through May providing service opportunity for the club from Sierra Ridge Middle School.

The inexpensive and delicious breakfasts are \$3 per individual or \$7 for a family. The Community Center supports this project by charging a nominal fee for use of the facility to the club. Students benefit by learning how to make,

They use the proceeds to pay for projects that benefit the school, community and in fact a project for healthy water wherever needed, such as Africa, and a project for the eradication of Polio.

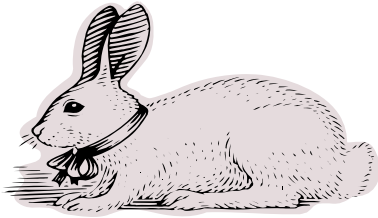
